Those with a working knowledge of sewing machines will be invited to assist with one or more sewing classes.

We set out to spread the love of Jesus to the low income communities of the Ensenada Baja area. But, we often come back more blessed and changed ourselves. Expect the unexpected!

arrived. More requests were added daily. Miss Tina had found a location for another jungle gym—at a church in Richton,




20+ miles north. We were able to complete nine complete sets of steps, one new jungle gym and one complete ramp. The lawn crew worked hard every day. Other improvements and
