## **MOSES WEEKEND TRIPS**

Want to serve but can't commit to a long mission trip? What about going on a MOSES weekend trip? MOSES weekend trips are designed for church youth groups, Bible study groups, family groups and much more. Weekend trips leave on Friday evening, travel to either Detroit or Chicago, and cost only \$50.00 per person. MOSES covers all transportation, leadership, work projects, accommodations and meals. MOSES weekend trips are designed to be a crosscultural experienced working in inner city Chicago or Detroit. MOSES has built many lasting friendships with the churches in both Chicago and Detroit, as well as with churches from the Grand Rapids area looking to serve.

Here is testimony by a church that has participated in one of those recent trips: Our church has done the same mission trip (to a local Christian camp for inner city kids) every year for the past ten years.



Last summer, some of the parents were hoping for a new experience for the teens. One of us had heard of MOSES and was on the mailing list receiving MOSES newsletters. We contacted your group and you helped us set up a trip to Chicago. We got an opportunity for us to "go to them" in the inner-city instead of "them" being brought to us. On our past mission trips we have seen what it was like for kids to experience camp environment

and be apprehensive about the noises of nature and the uncertainty of stepping into the woods for the first time. But this trip was different.

We got to see and experience the inner city in ways we had never thought about before. Our apprehension turned to excitement as we were able to work as a team to help in the remodeling and cleaning of a community center, feed breakfast to people who live and look different from us, and worship with brothers and sisters in Christ who have a joy that was contagious.





Our group (leaders and teens) felt this was the best mission trip they have been a part of, and we would love to do it again. We as leaders were able to rely on MOSES leaders to set everything up and could just show up and do the work that needed to be done. Thank you MOSES for your ministry! In 2013, we stayed at the Pequeños Hermanos Childrens' Home south of Ensenada. This was a very good arrangement for all of us. The children and their care-givers welcomed us warmly. We shared meals, play time, games and worship. We had our own quarters where we could sleep, have team devotions and keep our things secure.

The 2013 trip went so well, that we are planning to stay at the home again this summer. It is NOT too soon to sign up for this trip! Plan ahead to be sure you have a valid passport, state ID or enhanced driver's license. Our trip fees are about as low as any could possibly be, but if you still have difficultly raising the needed fees, we offer scholarship assistance. But start early and



be creative in raising your trip fees. Relatives and church members are often willing to assist in supporting teens who want to serve on a mission trip.

Once again, we expect to build one or more homes for needy families in the greater Ensenada area, assist with Vacation Bible School in several emerging churches in the community and provide a few sewing and canning classes in the more established churches. Our mission is never to replace on-going ministry, but to lend a hand and perhaps to share new ideas and materials.
